## ORDINANCE 04-41

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF EUSTIS, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 70, SECTION 70-103 OF THE EUSTIS CODE OF ORDINANCES TO ALLOW A POLICE CHIEF TO OPT OUT OF THE OFFICERS' PENSION PLAN; PROVIDING FOR POLICE SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND PROVIDING OF PUBLICATION IN ACCORDANCE TO THE LAW.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF EUSTIS, LAKE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Purpose: The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend Section 70-103 of Chapter 70 of the Eustis Code of Ordinances as follows:

**Section 1**. Section 70-103 of the Eustis Code of Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 70-103. Participation in plan mandatory.

Any police officer of the city who is eligible for inclusion into the police officers' plan must join this fund as a prerequisite to employment in the police department. Any police officer that meets that definition found in F.S. \$185.02(11) is eligible for inclusion in the plan. Provided, however the Police Chief shall have the option to participate or not participate in the plan pursuant to F.S. \$185.02(11).

**Section 2**. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not effect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, clauses or phrases of this ordinance, but they shall remain in effect, it being the legislative intent that this Ordinance shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately on passing.

Section 4. It is the intention of the City Commission of the City of Eustis that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the City of Eustis Code of Ordinances and that the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered and the word "Ordinance" may be changed to "Section", "Article", or such other appropriate word or phrase to accomplish such intentions.

Section 5. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be published in accordance with the requirements of law.
