1. Benefit Recalculations:

Mr. Baur reported that he had one remaining question with GRS regarding the re calculations and it has to do with the inclusion of workers comp as compensation for the Police Officers. Mr. Baur explained how some other municipalities handle workers comp. Mr. Harrison reported that the Ordinance is silent on the matter. Lt. White recommended that Mr. Baur looked at the history of other similar cases for example George Irvin or Daniel Lynch to see how it was previously handled. Mr. Baur reported that GRS has finished their review of the other recalculations and they have been approved. He is ready to move forward and send the notifications to the members.

1. Longevity Pay Discussion

Lt. White explained that the subject of the longevity pay had come up because a participant of the Plan wanted to enter the DROP but wanted to wait until the longevity bonus was paid. The Administrator had sent an e-mail to the Sheriff's office asking when this payment would occur. The Sheriff's office responded that former Lake Worth employees are not eligible for longevity pay at this time. Lt. White has spoken to Major Dan Smith and he explained that it is currently under review. Lt. White asked Mr. Harrison if the longevity pay was approved after someone enters the DROP or retires if his or her calculations would have to be recalculated to include this payment since it is pensionable. Mr. Harrison explained that yes the calculations would have to be recalculated, especially if it was paid retroactively.

He explained that these changes are for the General Plan. He does not have these changes for the Police Plan yet. Mr. Harrison explained that he had changed some existing language, re inserted it in the appropriate places in some case, and that the wording is based on IRS suggestions. The board had a discussion regarding these changes. The board would like to have Mr. Palmquist review the Ordinance Amendment before approving them.
