a. Police Actuarial Valuation - Sara Carlson, Foster & Foster

Ms. Carlson presented the 2018 Police Actuarial Valuation to the Board. The unfunded actuarial accrued liability has been paid off; the Plan is 100.2% funded. The minimum contribution should keep the Plan fully funded. The Board discussed State monies and how the Plan's status of being fully funded might affect that.

<u>POLICE:</u> MOTION TO APPROVE THE 2018 ACTUARIAL VALUATION WAS MADE BY MR. ZIRGIBEL AND SECONDED BY MS. LITZAN. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

b. Investment Consultant Report - Scott Owens & Andy McIlvaine, Graystone Consulting

Mr. Mcllavine reviewed the economy for the quarter at length. Diversification and defensive managers helped protect the Plan in the worst quarter since 2011. The market has since rebounded; it was the best January in 30 years.

Fire Summary of Relevant Facts

Mr. Owens reviewed the 12-31-18 quarterly report. The total portfolio was \$19,140,214.65 with a net rate of return of -8.54%. Mr. Owens reviewed the Plan's managers in detail. There was no need for rebalancing. Mr. Owens reviewed the compliance checklist with the Board. The total portfolio as of 02-04-19 was \$20,293,803 with a net rate of return of -3.3% FYTD.

Police Summary of Relevant Facts

Mr. Owens reviewed the 12-31-18 quarterly report. The total portfolio was \$15,048,675.57 with a net rate of return of -8.67%. Mr. Owens reviewed the Plan's managers and the compliance checklist; Graystone is currently still watching Fiera Capital. The total portfolio as of 02-02-19 was \$15,897,427 with a net rate of return of -3.6% FYTD. Mr. Owens reviewed the tactical asset allocation and Morgan Stanley's outlook going forward.

c. Attorney Report - Pedro Herrera, Sugarman and Susskind, PA

Mr. Herrera informed the Board that the ordinances were passed at the last City Council meeting. The Boards discussed the amount of time it took for both ordinances to be passed. Proposed House Bill 41 would amend chapter 112 to include correctional officers. The Police discussed how the Share Plan would be funded; this is a bargaining issue. The Summary Plan Descriptions will be updated after the Collective Bargaining Agreements are approved.

d. Administrator Report - Amber McNeill, The Resource Centers

Ms. McNeill provided the 2019 conference list to the Boards.

<u>POLICE:</u> MOTION TO APPROVE THE 02-07-19 POLICE BENEFIT APPROVALS WAS MADE BY MR. SCHETTINO AND SECONDED BY MR. ZIRGIBEL. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

Ms. McNeill and Mr. Schettino will be meeting with Brandi Garwood after the meeting regarding the payroll detail needed by Foster & Foster in order to complete the total compensation recalculations for the Police retirees.
